

**Lisbon Community School**  
**Joint Meeting with the City of Lisbon**  
**March 27, 2024 – Lisbon City Hall – 7:00 p.m.**

President Caspers called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Members present: Caspers, Baker, Prasil, Richey

Members absent: Mallie

Motion by Richey, second by Baker to approve the Agenda. All ayes motion carried (4-0).

City Administrator Brandon Siggins shared information regarding a new well on Market Street, the water project downtown, hydrant tie-in on South Street, future repair on old mains, the sanitary sewer at the new sports complex, the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase with ball diamonds going out to bid soon, work on Highway 30, housing, and a new cemetery map is now available online.

Superintendent Autumn Pino shared the 3 phases of the current facilities project; the 1<sup>st</sup> phase is done, we are currently in phase II with the CTE and weight room additions, and phase III will have some interior renovations. Also discussed were bi-weekly meetings that are taking place with the construction group, summer lobby work, the childcare crisis, continued LECC expansion, and a Childcare Summit coming up at Cornell on April 9<sup>th</sup>. She also thanked the City for fixing the batting cages, and noted that collaboration has been great.

The Lease Agreement was discussed, and there will be a walk-through of the facilities in April prior to when the school begins the lease in May. There has been a lot of good feedback on the lights, and everyone agreed that things have gone smoothly over the last couple of years.

Highway 30 parking was discussed, and Superintendent Pino noted that the school will not be having the large track meet this year due to construction and parking issues.

The next meeting will be held in October with a date TBD.

Motion by Richey, second by Baker to approve the purchase of a 2011 Truck for Lisbon CSD. All ayes motion carried (4-0).

Motion by Prasil, second by Baker to adjourn at 7:39 p.m. All ayes motion carried (4-0).
