Happy May! Clearly this month has gotten away from me since it's half over and you are just now getting an update from me. I apologize for this! It's been a great year and I look forward to a strong finish this school year. Listed below is relevant information for the month of may and dates to note. As always, thank you for your support and trusting us with your children. It means as much to me today as the first day I stepped on campus 6 years ago.

### **Important Information**

- Progress reports will be mailed home in the middle of June. Within your progress report you will find:
  - ISASP scores / report. They are re-norming ISASP grading scales so there is a chance that this will be delayed until the fall. If proficiency levels are not ready by mid-june I will make sure to communicate not to expect these in your progress report. Just a reminder this is only grades 3rd-6th.
  - FAST scores. Students will receive their reading and math FAST scores with family information to view their academic standing. Just a reminder that we take the following assessments for FAST:
    - K-1 Reading: Early Reading Assessment
    - 2-3 Reading: CBMR Assessment (Fluency)
    - 4-6 Reading: aReading Assessment (Comprehension, vocabulary, etc.)
    - K-1 Math: Early Math Assessment
    - 2-6 Math: aMath Assessment (Grade level math assessment)
  - Semester 2 progress reports from your classroom and specials teachers. This is the same report that you received for Semester 1 but updated for the content that has been taught since we returned in early January. I have attached an interpretation guide [HERE](#).

- Summer School communication will be coming in the month of June. This could look differently based upon where you are at in the process:
  - Receiving an invite because your child wasn't eligible after Semester 1.
  - Receiving communication from your assigned summer school teacher for scheduling.
